Policy name: Dress Code Policy

Purpose:

To set standards for the attire to be worn by all players and coaches on the field and in the dugouts, for our Little League and T-ball divisions which includes House League games, tournaments (both home and away) and special events (e.g. Opening Day, Championship Day).

POLICY

Players

All players are expected to wear their league-supplied team jersey, league-supplied team hat and long baseball pants to all games. All players on a team are expected to be dressed with the same look (hat, jersey, pants, socks) for their games. All players are expected to wear their jersey tucked into their baseball pants at all games.

Attire at practices is up to the coach. All players must still wear long pants.

No jewellery of any kind is permitted to be worn except that which identifies medical conditions. Baseball shoes are recommended. Sandals, flip flops, crocs etc. are not permitted.

Coaches

Coaches, both on-field and in the dugout, are expected to wear a collared golf style shirt and a league-supplied hat.

For Dundas Little League Opening Day, Championship Day, and District Tournaments, long pants are required. At District Tournaments, the pants must be a casual slack.

For Dundas Little League House League play, coaches may wear long pants or shorts. The pants or shorts must be business casual.

All attire must be presentable and in good condition.
